

IN THE COUNTY COMMISSION OF FAYETTE COUNTY, WEST VIRGINIA

ORDER

WHEREAS, the Fayette County Commission adopted a leash ordinance pursuant to the provisions of West Virginia Code, Chapter 19, Article 20, Section 6, as amended, and;

WHEREAS, said ordinance provides for impoundment at the Fayette County Humane Association facilities, and;

WHEREAS, the County Commission has ceased using the Fayette County Humane Association facilities, and;

WHEREAS, it is the intention of the Commission to provided for use of other impounding facilities in the future.

THEREFORE, upon motion duly made, seconded and unanimously passed, the Fayette County Commission hereby adopts the following amendment to the leash ordinance heretofore adopted:

All animals impounded by the Humane Officer of this County, the Fayette County Sheriff's Department, or such other agency which may have authority to impound animals in this County, shall impound them at the Fayette County Animal Shelter, or such other location as may from time to time be designated by this Commission.




