



WEATHER HIGHLIGHTS / IMPACTS


- What: Extreme Cold Watch.. Dangerously cold wind chills as low as 15 degrees below across the lowlands and as low as 28 degrees below in the northeast mountains are possible.
- When: Late Sunday night through Wednesday morning for lowlands, through Thursday morning for the northeast mountains.
- Where: Area-wide.
- Confidence: High.
- Impacts: Wind chills as low as 15 below or below could result in hypothermia if precautions are not taken. Frostbite and hypothermia will occur if unprotected skin is exposed to these temperatures. An extended period of freezing temperatures could cause ruptured water pipes.
- What: Winter Storm Watch. Heavy snow is possible. Total snow accumulations between 4 and 7 inches possible. Wind gusts as high as 40mph.
- When: Late Saturday night through Monday morning.
- Where: Northeast mountains and portions of northern and southeast West Virginia.
- Confidence: Medium and increasing.
- **Impacts:** Travel could be very difficult. The hazardous conditions could impact the Monday morning commute.












Wind Chill Values
