The position was created due to the importance of having input from the Vendor Community to the overall event and local community.

- This position does require knowledge and experience of the event with regard to the community and vendor experience
- The applicant needs to be someone from the local Fayette County Community who is or has been a Bridge Day Vendor or volunteer and understands how the day progresses
- Typically, the Bridge Day Commission meets monthly on the third Wednesday of the month at 1:30. We meet either on Zoom, in the Fayetteville Town Hall or in the Fayette County Commission chambers in Fayetteville
